Music for unity and hope

HS African percussion ensemble performs with authentic instruments

The Penn Manor High School Spring Concert in May featured an unusual group of performers – an authentic African percussion ensemble performing as a tribute to Nelson Mandela and his influence on democracy.

The multi-cultural repertoire celebrated the key role music played in the effort to keep spirits up and encourage unity and hope in the face of oppression under Apartheid in South Africa.

During the concert, students performed on authentic African percussion instruments that were purchased through a grant from the Penn Manor Education Foundation.

Before the instruments arrived in March, students prepared by listening to authentic recordings of the pieces they would perform so they could begin transcribing rhythmic parts.

According to Penn Manor High School choral instructor Lauren Forbes, the act of transcribing parts from listening to

performances and learning by ear is characteristic of this type of music, which is typically spread by word of mouth and often is not written down.

Students who were already percussionists in the band played the various drums: bongos, djembe, dunun and Latin cajon. Volunteers from the chorus played the auxiliary percussion instruments: togo seed rattle, gankogui bell and axatse shekere (beaded gourd rattle).

"The fact that we have and get to use these unique instruments is pretty great," said Caleb Breidenbaugh, one of the students who performed in the ensemble.

The dunun Caleb played, nicknamed "fuzzy drum" for its goat hide surface, was made in Ghana.

Another student, Alex Thomas, said his family members at the concert "thought it was pretty cool that I got to play an instrument that they had never seen or heard of before."

"Having these authentic instruments enhanced the African style of each piece we played," said a third student, Peter Dutton. "Even the bells [made in Zimbabwe] were very authentic, and we were using them in an authentic setting."

Anne Kinderwater Carroll will assume the role of executive director of the Penn Manor

Education Foundation beginning Jan. 1. She replaces Donald Stewart, who has served as director for five years and who previously served Penn Manor School District as superintendent.

Anne is well known to Penn Manor families as a former middle school science

teacher and Penn Manor Teacher of the Year. She also was principal at both Marticville Middle and Eshleman Elementary schools.

In 2010, after 17 years as a Penn Manor staff member, Anne left education to devote more attention to her family, including her husband of 14 years, Andrew, and the couple's two daughters, Helena, 8, and Evelyn, 5.

While Anne considers her role as wife and mother her number one priority, she has remained extremely active in community service and advancing the goals of public education.

She is a classroom volunteer in Junior Achievement, a program her father helped initiate in the Lancaster area back in 1950. Through her involvement at St. John's Episcopal Church, Anne supports the Rafiki educational outreach program in Kenya.

An adjunct professor at Millersville University, she has served as a supervisor of both student teachers and candidates for principal certification.

Most importantly, Anne will bring to the role of executive director an experienced knowledge of the values and expectations of our community. She was a much-respected member of the Penn Manor staff and will serve as an outstanding facilitator of the Education Foundation's mission to enhance learning opportunities for our students.

Dr. Frerichs named ambassador

The Penn Manor Education Foundation Board has selected a champion of public education and a great friend of both Penn Manor School District and its Foundation, Dr. Rich Frerichs, as its Ambassador for 2014-2015.

While Dr. Frerichs has supported Penn Manor in a variety of roles, he is most proud of his role as a Penn Manor parent. His two daughters are PMHS graduates – Kimberlee in 1999 and Melissa in 2001. Kimberlee has pursued a career in finance, and Melissa currently is Penn Manor School District's Supervisor of English and Language Arts.

Rich also is proud of his role in support of a former Penn Manor golf coach, his late wife, Marsha. Serving as coach between 2004 and 2008, Marsha Frerichs was an inspiration to her students and often a "second Mom" to golf team members.

The Frerichs family currently sponsors a Penn Manor Education Foundation scholarship that honors Marsha's memory and is designed to reward both a male and

Dr. Frerichs' contributions to our community often take the form of sharing his leadership skills. Rich has been a member of Penn Manor School Board since 1997. He served as vice president for 10 years and as president for three years, from 2009 to 2012.

Helping to lead schools all across our state, Dr. Frerichs recently was elected president of the Pennsylvania School Boards Association.

Additionally, Rich directly served Penn Manor Education Foundation as a board member for eight years and as its secretary between 2000 and 2007.

While Dr. Frerichs has been an active and generous volunteer on behalf of Penn Manor schools and children, his career also has been devoted to improving the quality of education for students across Pennsylvania.

During his 36-year career at Millersville University, Rich has been Professor of Education Foundations and Dean of Resident Life and has coordinated the Field Service Program for student teachers.

You may also be familiar with Rich as the voice of the Millersville University football team and the Lady Marauders women's basketball team.

Last year, the Penn Manor Education Foundation initiated the Foundation Ambassador program to recognize individuals who have made improving our community a lifelong priority. In the inaugural year, the Ambassadors were Martha and Willis
